Finally, after a string of superb saves from Saad, West Borough scored from close range early in the second half. However Boughton continued to fight hard and began to create chances from balls coming in from the wings.

In the very last minute of the match, Jack beat his man on the right of the pitch and sent in an accurate and powerful cross into the box for William to head in to the top left-hand corner of the goal. The match finished 1:1.

It was an excellent performance from Boughton, with Saad being nominated Man of the match.
